READ LISTEN OBEY SHARE

Read

Is to take the time to go through passages of Scripture and see what God was doing back then and what He is saying to you now.

Listen

Is to pray through the passage and see what God is saying through the Word with the help of the Holy Spirit.

Obey

Once you have an idea of what God is calling you to do as a result of what you read, it is important to ensure you obey it. To do what God is calling you to do!

Share

To then share this with others around you.
