## Parable of the Mustard Seed: Matthew 13:31-33

### Supplies Needed:

(These supplies can be used during the video to help tell the story or afterwards)

- To create a tree (pipe cleaners or sticks or construction paper)
- Beads      - Seeds      - Playdough

### Questions & Creations:

(These are suggestions for your family to explore God's Word together through conversation and play)

#### Family Questions:

- Who was Jesus talking to when he shared this parable?
- How do you think the people would have felt when Jesus told them that the long awaited Kingdom of Heaven would begin as a mustard seed?
- Can you think of a time in the Bible when it talks about the Kingdom coming?
- Why do you think God choose to initiate his Kingdom coming in a seemingly simple beginning?



#### Kids ask Parents:

- Share the time when you first became a part of God's Kingdom (family)?
- Is there someone we know that isn't a part of God's family yet?

### Recreate:

As a family, you can create a tree using the supplies above. This tree can represent the Kingdom of God that's growing in the world.
