

Position summary:

The purpose of this position is to provide an individual with ministry leadership experience under the guidance of an existing ministry leader.

Position accountability:

This individual would be accountable to the Executive Pastor through the Associate Pastor of Connection and Community who will oversee the internship.

Key position responsibilities:

1. Mentorship Relationship

To participate in a mentoring relationship with a designated Director in the ministry area requested. This will include one on one meetings to discuss issues relating to leadership, evaluation and feedback of the intern on different aspects of ministry leadership, and participating in setting the vision and direction of the children and youth ministries at SouthRidge. These meetings would occur weekly.

2. Leadership Development

To be given leadership roles within the children's and youth ministries that are designed to expand the intern's ministry experience as well as provide opportunities for feedback and evaluation.

- The intern will be expected to participate with SRKids and/or Youth Leadership teams.
- The intern will be given different leadership responsibilities during Sunday morning and mid-week ministries, as well as summer events. Responsibilities may include; planning an event, taking leadership for certain portions of an event, and delivering biblical messages to children and families.
- The intern will be expected to form discipling relationships with children and/or families that may include time spent outside of Sunday mornings or other major events.
- The intern will work/volunteer with local community organizations such as the Langley Foodbank to help strengthen partnerships within our community.
- The intern will be expected to fill a leadership role for one week at Camp Qwanoes

3. Events

To participate in SouthRidge events and services that are not children and family focused so that the intern will understand and participate in church life beyond just children's and family ministries. This participation will not be included in the interns weekly hours.

4. Educational Requirements

To finish the GED.

5. SouthRidge Staff

The Intern as part of the SouthRidge staff:

- Will be encouraged to attend a minimum one staff meeting a month
- Will contribute to the broader fulfillment of the vision and accomplishment of long and short term goals of the church by working with other staff and ministry leaders

Qualifications expected:

This individual will:

- Have a heart for God and a heart for children and youth.
- Understand, agree with, and live out the mission and vision of SouthRidge Fellowship.
- Have a passion to see individuals come to know God and grow in their relationship with Him.
- Will meet the character qualifications as outlined in the character profile

Terms of employment:

This is a paid position. Other employment specifics can be found in the employment contract.

- will be able to derive clear application for living for children from Biblical texts
