

**Summer Intern Job Descriptions –
Canada Summer Jobs Funding Application 2024**

Children, Youth and Family Internship

- Coordinate weekly programs for children and youth in our Langley Community. This includes coordinating volunteers and organizing and leading programs/events. All children's and youth programs provide assistance for children with disabilities and involve working together with volunteers of all ages.
- Will be involved in creating and planning summer events and activities for children and their families in Langley of all ages and abilities including supports for children with disabilities. These events will require administrative responsibilities, acquiring resources, recruiting and directing youth and adult volunteers.
- Assist with our THRIVE Ministry that is geared to support families with children and teens with disabilities so that they become a valuable part of our church and greater community.
- Create a summer program to provide mentoring and support for children and families through skill development workshops.
- Fill a leadership role for one week at Camp Qwanoes which is a youth-oriented, high-adventure, non-profit Christian camp on Vancouver Island that serves kids and families on Vancouver Island and the Lower Mainland.
- Strengthening our partnership with the local community foodbank through serving at their facility to hand out food to our Langley families in need.

Community Support Engagement Internship

- Create a summer program that continues our connections within the Langley community including Raphael House Refugee Ministry, Langley Foodbank and our local community of Ukraine Refugees.
- Build relationships with key community leaders to identify and meet specific needs as discovered.
- Create weekly connection opportunities for people to meet others and gather support.
- Create larger events that rally greater community support for these groups so that significant community connection takes place.
- Build a Support Network Team that will carry this ministry on beyond the summer that will provide ongoing care, support and resources to these key areas of population.
