MEAL TIME CONVERSATION #1

Talk about:

Talk about how the bible says we are like sheep and how a shpeherd cares for the needs of his sheep (ie. protection, help not getting lost, food) and how Jesus does the same for us.



MEAL TIME CONVERSATION #2

Talk about:

Talk about what it means to listen to Jesus' voice and how we can follow Jesus by getting to know him better through reading the Bible and talking to him (praying) each day.

SHEPHERD SAYS:

Play:

This game is just like Simon Says. You and your child can take turns being the Shepherd and the Sheep. (See ideas below)

Talk:

Talk to your child about how we need to listen to and follow Jesus our Shepherd, who promises to take care of us. Sometimes we will not follow Jesus' voice and make poor choices that can hurt us or make us feel sad. We can be so thankful that if we ask Jesus to forgive our sin/poor choices, he will once again lead us back towards his loving care.

The Shepherd Says: scratch your back

Eat your grass. (Nooo! The Shepherd didn't say that!)

The Shepherd says: jump up and down

The Shepherd says: follow me around the pen (lead child(ren) in a line around room)
