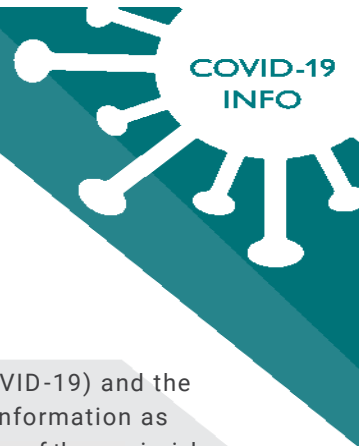

COVID – 19 Safety Plans

***As per Dec 20, 2021 revised restrictions – no changes were announced for church services.**

SouthRidge Covid Protocols

The following protocols are the most recent due to new BC Health Orders revisions (Dec 20, 2021)

1. **Worship Services**

Masks are required for our services, including when singing. Worship services are limited to 50% capacity.

2. **Youth and Children's programs**

We are following the school mandates for masks, so children ages 5+ are required to wear masks, as well as our volunteers.

3. **Office/Building usage during the week**

We require masks in all common areas.

4. **Large SouthRidge Events**

Masks are required for all events. Size restrictions are dependent on the rooms being used for the event.

5. **Community Groups**

These are limited to your household plus up to 10 guests with everyone 12 years and older being fully vaccinated.

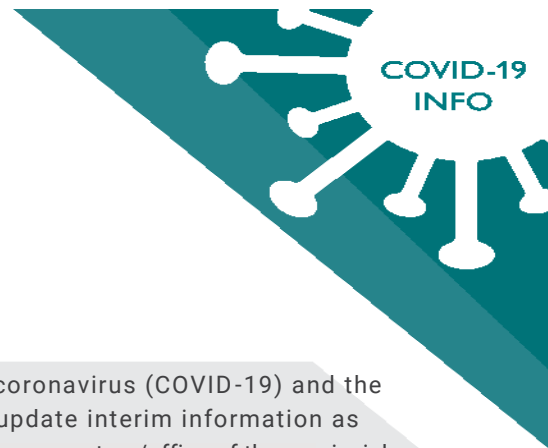
6. **Rentals**

Everyone is required to wear masks during their rental event. Rental events are limited to 50% of room capacity and vaccine passports are required.

7. Funerals and Weddings

Masks are mandatory for all funerals and weddings. Staff/volunteers serving at the event are required to wear masks (not when they are on stage). As per indoor event restrictions, weddings and funerals are capped at 50% capacity with all guests aged 12 and up required to be fully vaccinated. Vaccine passports are required. No wedding/funeral receptions are permitted at this time.

8. If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, they are asked to stay home and not come to any church activity unless showing a negative Covid Test and until symptoms resolve themselves:

- Fever higher than 38 degrees Celsius
- Chills
- Cough
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Difficulty breathing
