COVID – 19 Safety Plans

*As per March 10, 2022 revised restrictions – there are no longer any restrictions for church services.

SouthRidge Covid Protocols

The following protocols are the most recent due to new BC Health Orders revisions (Mar. 10, 2022)

1. Worship Services

Masks are no longer required for our services, including when singing. However if you are more comfortable wearing a mask please do so. Worship services have no capacity limitations.

2. Youth and Children's programs

We no longer require children or volunteers to wear masks. However if you are more comfortable wearing one then please do.

3. Office/Building usage during the week

We no longer require masks in common areas, however if you are more comfortable wearing a mask we respect that.

4. Large SouthRidge Events

Masks are not required for events.

5. Community Groups

No size restrictions.

6. Rentals

Masks are no longer required and there is no capacity limit.



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7. Funerals and Weddings

Masks are not required for weddings or funerals unless you feel more comfortable doing so. There is no size limitation on groups.

- 8. If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, they are asked to stay home and not come to any church activity unless showing a negative Covid Test and until symptoms resolve themselves:
 - Fever higher than 38 degrees Celsius
 - Chills
 - Cough
 - · Loss of sense of smell or taste
 - Difficulty breathing
