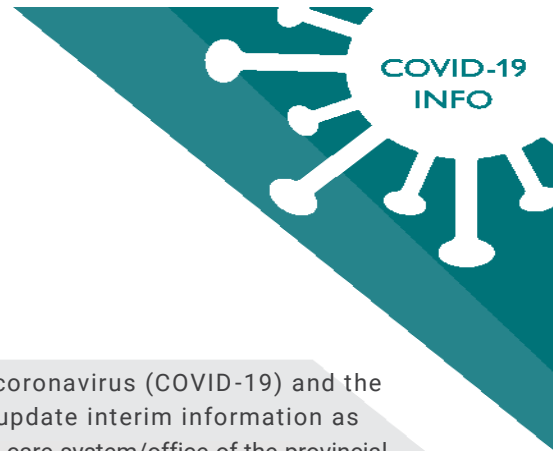

COVID – 19 Safety Plans

SouthRidge Covid Protocols

The following protocols are the most recent due to new BC Health Orders revisions

- 1. Worship Services have no restrictions from BC Health Officer.**
 - a. Masks are recommended but not mandated for all attending Sunday church services.
 - b. Masks will be required for staff and volunteer leaders & kids from Kindergarten and up at all times when in the building. When outside, masks will not be required.

- 2. Events/Meetings and Program Updates**
 - a. **Mid-Week:**
 - i. Upon entering and moving around the church building common areas such as foyer, halls, washrooms, etc. everyone is required to wear a mask.
 - ii. All volunteer leaders and staff are required to wear masks when working with kids and teens.
 - iii. All kids/teens from Kindergarten and up are required to wear masks at all times when in the building.

- 3. If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, they are asked to stay home and not come to any church activity unless showing a negative Covid Test and until symptoms resolve themselves:**
 - Fever higher than 38 degrees Celsius
 - Chills
 - Cough
 - Loss of sense of smell or taste
 - Difficulty breathing
