# COVID – 19 Safety Plans

## SouthRidge Covid Protocols

The following protocols are the most recent due to new BC Health Orders revisions

### 1. **Worship Services**

Masks are recommended for our services. Volunteers are required to wear masks (yes, this is more than we are required to do). There are no meeting size restrictions.

### 2. **Youth and Children's programs**

We are following the school mandates for masks, so children ages 5+ are required to wear masks, as well as our volunteers.

### 3. **Office/Building usage during the week**

We require masks in all common areas. Masks are optional in office area and classrooms.

### 4. **Large SouthRidge Events**

Masks are recommended for all events larger than 50 people. Volunteers are required to wear masks.

### 5. **Community Groups**

Are considered personal gatherings if done in homes and do not have any restrictions, unless in the eastern Fraser Valley health region. Then restrictions apply (must be fully vaccinated, may only have 5 additional visitors in their home)

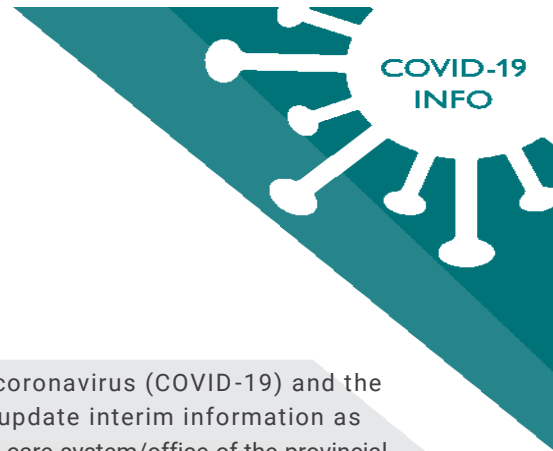
### 6. **Rentals**

Everyone is required to wear masks during their rental event. If the event is greater than 50 people, vaccine passport is in effect.

## 7. Funerals and Weddings

Masks are mandatory for all funerals and weddings. Staff/volunteers serving at the event are required to wear masks (not when they are on stage). If a funeral/wedding has more than 50 people, vaccine passport is required.

## 8. If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, they are asked to stay home and not come to any church activity unless showing a negative Covid Test and until symptoms resolve themselves:

- Fever higher than 38 degrees Celsius
- Chills
- Cough
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Difficulty breathing
